- Nominator's cover letter that provides a rationale statement describing how the project exemplifies the economic, social and environmental principles of sustainability, the merits and title of the project, a clear description of the innovation in sustainability, the anticipated advantages to be obtained through replication, and a statement of how the sustainable project met the client's needs.
- 2. The completed entry form.
- 3. Not more than four color photographs, including captions, depicting the project and its innovation in sustainability.

Entries are due to the Honors and Awards Program office by 5:00 PM Eastern Time, November 1.

Important note: If Novembere 1 falls on a weekend, the nomination deadline automatically moves to the next business day.
