Member Grade (M. ASCE)

- Maintain State licensure
- Ensure you have responsible charge of projects or have the role of Associate Professor or higher (academic)
- Complete Application for election to ASCE Fellow by the Membership Application Review Committee (MARC)

Fellow Grade (F. ASCE)

- Maintain Membership
- Update credential on personal and professional documents
- Proudly hang ASCE Fellow certificate
- Proudly wear your Fellow lapel pin

ASCE Fellow Minimum Requirements

- Current ASCE member
- AND be a licensed Professional Engineer or Professional Land Surveyor in the United States or in the country in which the member resides (if such licensure is available)
- AND nominated by an organizational entity of the Society (this includes Section or Branch Presidents, Board of Direction members, Institute Board of Governors members, and Chairs of Standing Board Committees)
- AND have had responsible charge for not less than 10 years, in the grade of Member, of important work in engineering or surveying and be qualified to direct, conceive, plan, or design engineering works OR have had responsible charge for not less than 10 years, in the grade of Member, of important industrial, business, construction, educational, editorial, research, or engineering society activity, requiring the knowledge and background gained from engineering training and experience
