In 1949, the Board authorized a miniature lapel pin to accommodate changing clothing styles. This was replaced in 1963 by a smaller lapel-size official badge. In the late 1960s, special adaptations of the official shield identified Past-Presidents and Honorary Members.

For many years, the badges were numbered and inscribed with the holder's name, which led to some unusual experiences. In 1912, a badge still attached to the remnants of a vest was taken from the stomach of a shark
