Introduction

All Younger Member Groups are eligible for this award. The purpose of this award is to recognize the efforts and to promote excellence among Younger Member Groups. Achievements of Younger Member Groups in both small and large categories will be recognized; one Younger Member Group in each category is eligible to receive the award. Size categories consist of Younger Member Groups from large Sections and Branches (Section membership greater than 1,000 and Branch membership greater than 250); and Younger Member Groups from small Sections and Branches (Section membership of 1,000 and less; and Branch membership of 250 and less).

- Please type or neatly print.
- Please USE THE FORM. Nominations not utilizing the form will be disqualified.
- Attachments are encouraged, but should be well referenced.
- Contact member information and Section/Branch endorsement are essential.
- Groups are not required to participate in all categories.
- Where possible, please submit two-sided copies.

SOCIAL (20 Points)

List **social activities**, locations, number in attendance, and dates which were sponsored to encourage younger member involvement. (1 to 4 points each, up to 20 points).

PROFESSIONAL (28 Points)

Activities:

Sponsor Professional seminars, short courses, speakers bureau, career day, and meetings. List titles, locations and dates. (1 to 2 points each, up to 8 points).

Council Meetings: Participate in Younger Member Zonal Council Meetings and/or Younger Member Leadership Symposium. List names, activity and dates. (1 point each, up to 4 points).

Officers and Committee Members: Younger Members who serve as national or local officers, or who serve on national or local professional committees. List names and titles. (1 point each, up to 4 points).

Awards:

Submit National Award Nominations: Submit nominees for National Younger Member Awards (Daniel Mead, Edmund Friedman, Young CE in Government, Younger Member Group, or Employer Recognition). List names submitted for each award. (2 points each, up to 6 points).

Award Winners: Winners of Younger Member Awards, National, Zonal, Section, or Branch. Describe the award and give names and dates of recipients. (2 points each, up to 6 points).

SCHOOL INVOLVEMENT (16 Points)

Conduct Student Outreach Program. Describe local grade/middle/high school outreach program. (Up to 5 points).

Contests: Participate in local grade/middle/high school technical contests (science fairs, Mathcounts, Sim-city, etc.). Describe the activity and provide dates. (Up to 4 points).

Present Awards: Present awards to grade, junior/senior high school or college students. Provide a description of the award, and give names and dates of recipients. (Up to 3 points).

Student Chapter Contact Member: Contact Member for ASCE Student Chapter who is a Younger Member. Give Student Chapter and Younger Member names. (Up to 2 points).

Joint Student Chapter: Conduct joint activity with local ASCE Student Chapter/Club. Describe activity and give dates and attendance. (Up to 2 points).

COMMUNITY SERVICE (10 Points)

Sponsor Community Service Activity. Describe activity, dates and attendance. (2 to 5 points each, up to 10 points).

TECHNICAL (26 Points)

Activities:

Sponsor technical seminars, short courses, or meetings. List titles, locations and dates. (2 points each, up to 4 points).

Sponsor technical field trips. List facility/project visited, date and attendance. (2 points each, up to 6 points).

Technical presentation: Present technical papers or other presentation at ASCE or other technical seminar or short course. List title, locations, dates and presenter. (2 points each, up to 6 points).

Technical Officer/Committee Members. Younger Members serving as national or local technical committee officers/members. List names and titles. (1 point each, up to 4 points).

Awards:

Technical Awards: Younger Member winners of ASCE national or local technical awards or technical awards presented by other societies. List the name of the award, society, recipient and date. (2 points each, up to 6 points).

PUBLICATIONS (21 Points)

Younger Member Newsletter, newsletter article or regular column in the Section or Branch newsletter. Attach all copies. (1 point for each issue/column, up to 6 points)

YM Article published in ASCE national or local technical or professional publication e.g. CE Magazine, ASCE News, ASCE journals or proceedings of the ASCE conferences (NOT newsletters). List name of author, title of article, name of publication and date published. (2 points each, up to 10 points).

YM Article published in newsletters, newspapers, or general magazines other than ASCE. List name of author, title of article, name of publication and date published. (1 point each, up to 5 points).

SPECIAL ACTIVITIES (10 Points)

Describe other activities NOT COVERED UNDER OTHER SECTIONS OF THIS NOMINATION FORM. These include Community Service Projects, hosting of regional meetings, student outreach projects, etc. Describe the activity and give dates, locations and number in attendance. (1 to 10 points each, up to 10 points).
