Eligibility requirements:

- 1) Any currently enrolled civil engineering student, who will be either a junior or senior in the fall, and is enrolled in an ABET-accredited civil engineering program, is a United States citizen, and has a passion for bridges may apply for this scholarship. Applicant must be an ASCE student member in good standing at the time of application and award.
- 2) A scholarship may be awarded only to a student who will employ it to continue his/her formal undergraduate education at a recognized educational institution.
- 3) Selection is based on appraisal of the applicant's award justification, stated interest in bridge design and construction, educational plan, academic performance and standing, development potential, leadership capacity, and financial need.

Applications must include: Check all that apply.

- Completed application form, including faculty member's original signature, name and contact information..
- Personal statement (1000 to 1,500 words) addressing why the award should be given to the applicant, the applicant's interest in bridge design or construction, and plans for continuing formal education.
- Brief financial plan outlining how the applicant will finance his/her education if an award is granted.
- Detailed annual budget.
- Minimum of two **sealed** letters of recommendation, one of which must be from a faculty member. Each letter sealed in its own envelope with the recommender's signature across the flap.

One sealed official transcript from each school attended. Can be sent separately, but must be received by application deadline.

- Transcript enclosed.
- Transcript being sent by Registrar's Office.
- One-page résumé. Include honors, activities, organizations, ASCE activities (including any offices held), and any work experience.
- Any additional information/documentation that would support the applicant's interest in bridges.

Procedure:

One **complete** application package containing one original of all items listed above must be **received** by ASCE Honors and Awards Program by February 10. **All items must be collected by the applicant and sent to ASCE Honors and Awards Program as one complete application package.** Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

Award:

One applicant may be selected for award, which is in the range of \$3,000. Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition, fees and related expenses, and will be disbursed in the fall term. Recipient will be eligible to interview for an internship opportunity by the Figg Engineering Group.

Deadline: Applications and Transcripts Must Be Received by February 10
