Dear New England Council:

In response to your resolution 2010-01, the Region 1 Board of Governors discussed your resolution via teleconference and at the September 2010 Assembly at Cornell University. The Board recognizes and agrees with your desire for the Region and Regional Governors to be more actively involved with student activities, specifically student conferences. To that end, the Board has been directed to ask to individuals (Ted Green – NJ Section and Ammie Rogers – Boston Section) to accept a role as the student activity coordinator for the Region. The goal is to have a mechanism for the Board to be updated as to events in the Region that should be attended by member(s) of the Board.

The possibility of providing monetary support to student chapters has been discussed. During the current fiscal year (2010 – ends on September 30), the Regional Board distributed \$1250 to student chapters for their use in participation in national steel bridge and concrete canoe competitions. The Board discussed monetary contributions at the September 2010 Assembly. Due to increased travel expenses and meeting costs, it appears that financial support will not be possible this year.
