

A RESOLUTION

Recognizing and Celebrating Engineers Week to Honor the Contributions of Engineers and Promote STEM Education.

WHEREAS, Engineers Week is observed nationally to recognize the critical role engineers play in safeguarding public health, safety, and welfare, and in advancing innovation, infrastructure, and economic growth; and

WHEREAS, engineering is a profession grounded in rigorous education, training, and licensure, applying principles of mathematics, science, and technology to design, build, and maintain systems essential to modern life; and

WHEREAS, professional engineers contribute to the development and maintenance of safe roadways, bridges, transit systems, airports, and energy infrastructure, ensuring reliable delivery of essential services; and

WHEREAS, engineers are instrumental in providing clean drinking water, wastewater treatment, stormwater management, and environmental restoration, thereby improving public health and protecting natural resources; and

WHEREAS, engineering disciplines—including civil, mechanical, electrical, structural, environmental, chemical, and others—support sustainable development and technological advancement across both public and private sectors; and

WHEREAS, modern life would be unrecognizable without the contributions of engineers, whose work drives economic growth, fosters innovation, and enhances quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Engineers Week promotes awareness among students, educators, and families of the importance of STEM education and encourages young people to pursue careers in engineering, ensuring a diverse and well-prepared future workforce; and

WHEREAS, according to the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics, there are more than 1.7 million practicing engineers nationwide, and demand for engineering professionals continues to grow to meet future challenges; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF [STATE NAME]:
