A RESOLUTION

Recognizing and Celebrating Infrastructure Week to Highlight the Importance of Modern, Resilient, and Sustainable Infrastructure.

WHEREAS, infrastructure—including transportation systems, water and wastewater facilities, energy networks, broadband, and public buildings—forms the backbone of economic growth, public safety, and quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Infrastructure Week is observed nationally to raise awareness of the critical need for investment in modern, resilient, and sustainable infrastructure that meets the demands of the 21st century; and

WHEREAS, well-maintained infrastructure supports commerce, connects communities, ensures access to clean water and reliable energy, and strengthens emergency preparedness and disaster resilience; and

WHEREAS, engineers, planners, builders, and public officials work tirelessly to design, construct, and maintain infrastructure systems that safeguard public health and safety while promoting environmental stewardship; and

WHEREAS, aging infrastructure and emerging challenges—including climate change, population growth, and technological innovation—require strategic planning and investment to ensure long-term reliability and sustainability; and

WHEREAS, Infrastructure Week provides an opportunity to engage citizens, businesses, and policymakers in dialogue about the importance of infrastructure and the need for continued investment and innovation; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF [STATE NAME]:
