

J. WALDO SMITH HYDRAULIC FELLOWSHIP

Eligibility requirements:

- 1) At the time of application and award the individual must be a member of the Society in good standing. Preference shall be given to Associate Members.
- 2) At the time of application and award the individual must be enrolled as a civil engineering graduate student at an accredited educational institution.
- 3) The scope of the fellowship should be restricted to research in the field of experimental hydraulics as distinguished from that of purely theoretical hydraulics. Emphasis is to be placed on practical experiments designed and executed for the purpose of advancing knowledge with respect to the laws of hydraulic flow, rather than to the type of research which proceeds on the theory of mathematical analysis based on assumptions of unknown validity. The purpose of the research is to test the assumptions that are currently made and to develop a better understanding of fluid flow. The purpose of the award is to encourage research in the field of experimental hydraulics.

Applications must include:

- Completed application form.
- Personal 500-word essay on why the applicant should receive this fellowship and why the applicant chose to become a civil engineer, specific ASCE Student Chapter involvement, any special financial needs, and long term goals and plans.
- Description of the proposed research and its objectives, signed by an institutional representative indicating proposed research is acceptable.
- Detailed budget utilizing attached template.
- Minimum of two recommendation letters, one of which must be from a faculty member.

One official transcript. Can be sent separately, but must be received by application deadline.

- Transcript enclosed
- Transcript being sent by Registrar's Office

**If applying for multiple fellowships,
only one transcript required.**

*If sending transcript separately, mail to ASCE Attn: Honors and Awards, 1801 Alexander Bell Drive, Reston, VA 20191.

- One- to two-page resume. Include honors, activities, organizations, ASCE activities (including any offices held), and any work experience.

Procedure:

One **complete** application package containing one original of all items listed above must be **received** by ASCE Student Services by February 10. **All items must be collected by the applicant and submitted as one complete application package (see Transcript note above).** Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

Award:

Up to \$4,000 is available, plus as much as \$1,000 more may be requested for equipment connected with the research. Such equipment becomes the property of the institution upon completion of the work.

Deadline: Applications and transcripts must be received by February 10
