

JOHN LENARD CIVIL ENGINEERING SCHOLARSHIP

Eligibility requirements:

- 1) Any currently enrolled civil engineering student in an ABET-accredited civil engineering or related program who will be registered as an undergraduate in fall of the year for which he/she is applying and has demonstrated a commitment to either water supply and/or environmental engineering may apply for this scholarship. Applicant must be a student member of the Society in good standing at the time of application and award.
- 2) The scholarships may be awarded only to those students who will employ them to continue their formal undergraduate education at a recognized educational institution.
- 3) Selection is based on appraisal of the applicant's award justification, stated interest in water supply and/or environmental engineering, educational plan, academic performance and standing, development potential, leadership capacity, and financial need.

Submit applications electronically to awards@asce.org as follows:

Student submits these items:

- Completed application form.
- Personal essay: What can the civil engineering profession do to improve the environment, and what would the applicant do as a civil engineer to improve the environment.
- Detailed annual budget using the attached budget template.
- Essay (500 to 1,000 words) on: What can the civil and environmental profession do to improve the environment and what would the applicant do as a civil engineer to improve the environment.
- One-page résumé. Include honors, activities, organizations, ASCE activities (including any offices held), and any work experience.

Two references each submit:

- A letter of recommendation, one of which must be completed by a faculty member, using the following subject line: **ASCE (name of Scholarship) reference for X (your last name).** **Reference letters sent by the student are not accepted.**

University Registrar submits:

- You must request your most recent transcript from your university's Registrar who will email it directly to awards@asce.org. Do not download a transcript from your university's site, as this is not considered an official transcript. You may submit a single transcript if you are applying for multiple scholarships.

Procedure:

One **complete** application package must be **received** by ASCE Honors and Awards Program by February 10. Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

Award:

Scholarships will be awarded based upon funds available and may be awarded to two recipients. Awards may be in the range of \$2,000. Scholarship funds are to be used for tuition and tuition related expenses and will be disbursed in the fall term.
