- 1) Any currently enrolled student who will be registered as an undergraduate in an ABET accredited program in civil engineering or related field in fall of the year for which he/she is applying. Applicants must be a member of his/her local ASCE Student Chapter and a student member of the Society in good standing at the time of application and award. No more than one application may be submitted from the membership of any one Student Chapter.
- 2) The scholarships may be awarded only to those students who will employ them to continue their formal undergraduate education.
- 3) Previous recipients of these scholarships are eligible to apply in any succeeding competition for these awards provided the other requirements of eligibility are satisfied.
- 4) Selection is based on the applicant's justification of award, educational plan, academic performance and standing, potential for development, leadership capacity, ASCE activities, and financial need.
