Eligibility requirements:

- 1) Grants are to provide for the exploration of new applications of geotechnical engineering or the earth sciences to social, economic, environmental and political issues.
- 2) Applicants must be practicing engineers or earth scientists, professors or graduate students, who are members of ASCE in good standing.
- 3) Selection is based on (a) technical and social value of the proposed research. Preference is given to research which will contribute to the solution of conflicting engineering issues involving social, economic, environmental, or political concerns or compromises; (b) ability of the proposed research to meet the overall objective of the fellowship; (c) relevant professional experience, previous research or course of study either as a practitioner or in academia; (d) prior contribution to the engineering profession and/or the applied earth sciences.
- 4) The fellowship may be awarded to co-researchers in a single project or divided among multiple projects. Previous recipients of the fellowship are eligible to apply in any succeeding competition for these awards provided the other requirements of eligibility are satisfied.

Applications must include: Check all that apply.

- Completed application form.
- 500-word personal essay on why the applicant should receive this fellowship and how it will be used.
- Detailed budget using the attached template.
- Description of the proposed research and its objectives; a statement from the institution at which the research is to be conducted indicating that the applicant and proposed research are acceptable to the institution must be included.
- Minimum of two recommendation letters; one must be from a faculty member/research nominator.

One official transcript. Can be sent separately, but must be received by application deadline.

- Transcript enclosed.
- Transcript being sent by Registrar's Office.

**If applying for multiple fellowships,
only one transcript required.**

*If sending transcript separately, mail to ASCE Attn: Honors and Awards, 1801 Alexander Bell Drive, Reston, VA 20191.

- One-page resume. Include honors, activities, organizations, ASCE activities (including any offices held), and any work experience.

Procedure:

One **complete** application package must be received by February 10. **All items must be collected by the applicant and submitted as one complete application package (see Transcript note above).** Application packages missing any of the above items will not be considered.

Award:

Fellowship will be awarded based on funds available. Awards have been in the \$2000 – \$6000 range. Award is to be used for expenses for research and experiments as stated in the eligibility requirements.
